FAST FACTS—RICHARD JAMES HICKS—FATHER OF JAMES HICKS

- 1st of our Hicks Family Members in Australia known
- Born in 1785 in Kent, England
- Crime - Unknown
- Trial — 3/10/1797 at Maidstone, Kent Quarters Sessions UK
- Sentence —To Be Transported for 7 Years
- Transported on *Canada*
- Sailed from Spithead UK on 21/6/1801
- Arrived Sydney Cove either 14/12/1801 or 31/1/1802
- Partner— Margaret Howe by 1806 until 1818 —but believed not to have married—no other partners
- Children with Margaret
 - Sarah Mary Hicks (Hust / Hurst / Herbert) - born 1806 at South Creek,
 - James Hicks—born 1810 at Windsor
 - Ann Hicks (Jackson ?) - born 1816 - place unknown
- Died in 1852 in Penrith—Reference— NSW BDM— V18521190 118/1852

Richard James Hicks—b 1785 Kent UK d 1852 Penrith

- Partner to **Margaret Howe** for period 1806-1818
 - **Daughter**—**Sarah Mary Hicks** b 1806 South Creek d 1880 Penrith
 - Married George Hurst at St Mary's & lived in Illawarra from around 1823-1825
 - Partner to William Bristow in 1828 Census in Illawarra
 - Married Joseph Herbert in 1855 Castlereagh
 - At least 3 children with Joseph Herbert
 - **Son**—**James Hicks** b 1810 Windsor d 1895 Bulli/Thirroul
 - Present in Illawarra in 1830's & from 1842
 - Married Margaret Daley/Brain 1834 at Penrith
 - 13 Children with Margaret
 - **Daughter**— **Ann Hicks** b 1816 d unknown
 - In household of William Bristow in Illawarra in 1828 Census
 - May have married Thomas Jackson in 1845
 - No. of Children unknown
